In the event of an emergency, please call 911

CALL IMMEDIATELY IF EXPERIENCING ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

- A brisk nose bleed that does not clear with pressure applied to the sides of the nose.
- Fever, purulent or green discharge from the eye or nose that may indicate an infection.
- Redness, swelling and tenderness of skin that is increasing.

DRESSING

PATIENT:

- If your eye is patched, remove the patch from the top down _____ in the morning _____ this evening.
- You may have a drip pad under your nose to collect drainage. Change this pad as needed. Once the drainage has stopped, you may remove pad. The drainage may last for 3 days.
- Expect your nose to be blocked for the first few days. Breathe through your mouth.
- DO NOT blow your nose or rub your eye for (7) days after surgery as you may dislodge the tube. Sniff and swallow to clear your nose as necessary.

COLD APPLICATION

• To reduce swelling and bruising, apply ice packs to the side of your nose for ______ days after surgery about 20 minutes of each hour until bedtime. You may use frozen peas or crushed ice in a small Ziploc bag covered with a soft cloth.

MEDICATIONS

- Continue your regular medications, including eye medications unless otherwise instructed by physician.
- Regular or Extra-strength Tylenol for mild pain. Prescription pain medication for moderate pain. Take with food.
- You were given pain medication at the surgery center. Next dose of medication should be taken at _
- DO NOT take aspirin, products containing aspirin or anti-inflammatory medications (i.e. Advil, Motrin, Aleve) for 2 days after surgery.
- Blood thinning medications such as Coumadin, Plavix or Aspirin can be restarted on _____
- Other medications:

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FLONASE/NASONEX	Spray puffs in the [R] [L] [both] nostril(s) times a day for days.
TOBRADEX EYE DROPS	Apply drop(s) to the [R] [L] eye(s) 4 times a day for days.
RX EYE OINTMENT	Apply to the stiches times daily, in the eyes at bedtime or whenever irritated. If Steri-Strips
	are taped over your incision, do not apply ointment to them.

ACTIVITY

- Rest quietly at home for two days after surgery. Stay in the company of a responsible adult for the first 24 hours.
 Sleep with your head elevated on 2-3 pillows.
- Avoid any strenuous activity, heavy lifting over 20 lbs., aerobic activity, bending or straining for 2 weeks following surgery and until approved by your surgeon.
- Do not drive while taking prescription pain medication.
- Return to work/school in _____ days.

HYGIENE

• You may shower 24 hours after surgery. Be careful using soap in the eye area.

DIET

- Resume regular diet. Drink cold liquids to stay hydrated. Avoid hot food/beverages for 24 hours.
- No alcoholic beverages the day of surgery or when taking prescription pain medication.
